

1970 TRANS-AM – Race 5 of 11 – BRIDGEHAMPTON

RESULTS of the Marlboro 200 for the SCCA Trans-American Championship held at Bridgehampton Race Circuit, Bridgehampton, New York, June 7, 1970.

Event sanctioned by the Sports Car Club of America, Inc., promoted by Bridgehampton Enterprises, Inc., organized by the New York Region (SCCA) and listed by the FIA as a national/open

Race on 2.85 mile circuit for SCCA Sedan over-2-liter cars for overall position.

Race length: 70 laps (195.5 miles), 2 hours, 12 minutes, 43.3 seconds.

Winners average speed 90.55 mph. Winner's margin of victory: 2 laps, 22.1 seconds.

Fastest race lap: Swede Savage, 1:42.4.

Fastest qualifier: Swede Savage, 1:43.0 (100.1 mph).
